Medley Hall is a fifteen minute walk or five minute cycle to the University of Melbourne. Located near Carlton Gardens, we are a short walk to the city centre and the bustling cafes and shops of Lygon street.

All 57 rooms in the main building are single occupancy and are equipped with a bed, desk, task lighting, chair, Wi-Fi internet, pin-board, bookshelves, built-in wardrobe, hydronic heating, and double-glazing. You bring personal items such as a computer, posters, bed linen and plants.




There are shared, self-contained bathrooms close to all bedrooms, and a kitchenette with a fridge, toaster, kettle and microwave on each floor. There are also laundry facilities and drying lines in the building.

Accessibility

Medley Hall is disability and wheelchair friendly. There is a lift, five accessible bedrooms, five bathrooms and one self-contained accessible apartment.

Cydelia House

Graduates, mature age and senior students may live at our other residence, Cydelia House, at 101-103 Drummond Street. Cydelia House has fully furnished rooms, large communal spaces, a fully-equipped modern kitchen and meals area and a garden.



Shared spaces and facilities

The College offers many spaces to use and enjoy, including two large study rooms, a roof terrace with views over the city, balcony, sitting room, movie room, and games room with kitchen. There are several pianos and a dedicated music room.

Food and dining

Three meals are provided daily during semester and healthy snacks are always available. The food at Medley Hall is really good, and we're committed to it being ethical, sustainable and largely plant based. Vegan, halal, gluten-free and specific allergy diets are catered for. All meals are served in the dining room in a relaxed family style.

Student Support

Medley Hall is an intellectually and socially invigorating residential community. There are students from many different nations and backgrounds, and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are strongly represented here.

The small size of the College means that it's easy to make friends and find your place. Students and staff work together to create an experience that suits the current cohort rather than being bound to past traditions.

Health and Wellbeing

Residents receive full membership to the University Sports Centre that has several gyms, fitness classes and team sports. The College also runs activities such as yoga and meditation, and there is a table tennis and pool table.


Our residential tutors and College staff are on hand to provide advice, support and pastoral care, and can link students with University services such as Counselling, Student Equity and Disability Support where needed.

Sustainability

The College was renovated with sustainability in mind. The building has features that reduce energy use and waste. There are rainwater tanks and double-glazing, beehives and vegetable gardens.

Academic Support

College tutorials are run by qualified tutors and we also offer skills-development workshops and one-on-one consultations. Medley Hall students also have the opportunity to attend tutorials at other colleges as part of the Intercollegiate Tutorial Program.



Fees

An all-inclusive fee covers accommodation for 39 weeks, which means that you don't have to move out during semester breaks. We also offer summer accommodation for students at a reduced rate.

Financial Support

The College offers financial aid to any students from the University of Melbourne who can demonstrate financial need. This means that not being able to afford the fees should not be a barrier to living here.

Many students at Medley receive financial support for one or more years of their residency.

Financial support is provided in the form of fee-remission bursaries. There is no academic requirement, rather a process of means-testing. This takes into account all other sources of financial support including help from parents and relatives, Centrelink payments, income and other scholarships. Contact us for an application form.
